Alsace shares a border with Germany and also its most famous grape, **RIESLING** though in Alsace you'll find it drier and a bit weightier. There are other aromatic varietals namely the spicy **GEWURZTRAMINER**, the perfumed **PINOT GRIS** and the peachy **MUSCAT**.

RHÔNE VALLEY

The Rhône Valley is really two regions in one, the North with **VIIGNIER**, **MARSANNE** and **ROUSSANNE** grown on steep, terraced vineyards dangling over the river; and the South, where blends of **GRENACHE BLANC** are grown on more gentle slopes studded with large rocks. Whites from these regions are rich, unctuous but rarely oaky with texture more akin to red wine than most whites.

RED WINE FROM FRANCE

BURGUNDY

When speaking about Burgundy, one rarely discusses the grape, **PINOT NOIR**, but rather the location of the vineyard and its classification, or Cru. Generally, the wines below come from the Cote d'Or and the string of villages after which the wines are named. A great Burgundy is the benchmark by which all Pinot Noir is judged and many believe Burgundy is the planet's finest wine region.
